Oakland For All – Beyond Accessible's annual Ramp Crawl is a fun, positive event that enables registered participants with the opportunity to experience many Oakland food and beverage establishments while raising awareness on accessibility. The Ramp Crawl positions Oakland as a thought leader in creating a more accessibility-friendly business district.

Oakland For All – Beyond Accessible is a unique campaign that brings together a diverse group of stakeholders committed to making the central Oakland business community a more accessibility-friendly neighborhood. This program was established in 2015 in light of the 25th anniversary of the signing of the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA). This legislation made it a violation of federal law to discriminate against people with disabilities, and Oakland For All – Beyond Accessible is focused on encouraging ADA compliance to eliminate the physical and societal barriers that prevent people with disabilities from fully participating in all aspects of public life.

The **Oakland For All** – **Beyond Accessible** program's main initiatives include being advocates for the creation of user friendly buildings, commercial establishments, public spaces and communities to transform Oakland into a model that can be replicated throughout the nation. Snapshot Oakland


As Pennsylvania's third largest area of economic activity and home to the region's universities and hospitals - Pittsburgh's largest employers, Oakland is one of the most popular destinations in western Pennsylvania. On a daily basis, over 100,000 people live, work, study and play in Oakland.

A culturally diverse community, Oakland is Pittsburgh's top destination for tourists and home to over 75 of the region's museums and cultural attractions including Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh, Phipps Conservatory & Botanical Gardens, Carnegie Library, Peterson Events Center, Soldiers & Sailors Memorial Hall and the University of Pittsburgh's Nationality Rooms and theaters. Total admissions at all of the nearby local attractions is estimated at about 1.8 million annually.

The Oakland neighborhood also boasts numerous unique shops and restaurants that cater to the melting pot of visitors, students and staff of the universities, hospitals and surrounding residential communities.




Metrics Annual Visitors

Event Details

The Oakland For All Ramp Crawl is an innovative event that provides participants an opportunity to experience ADA-compliant Oakland establishments in a fun way. Registered participants "crawl" to each of their assigned locations where they enjoy food and drink specials – all while raising awareness on the importance of accessibility.

In 2016, six businesses hosted four groups of "crawlers," and we had record breaking attendance with over 70 participants raising over \$1,000. Each Ramp Crawl event's ticket proceeds benefit the Oakland For All – Beyond Accessible program and its initiatives. Prominent local media outlets, KDKA & WTAE News, were onsite to provide coverage of the event. Participating food and beverage establishments included: Fuel & Fuddle, Garage Door Saloon, The Garden Grille & Bar at the Hilton Garden Inn Pittsburgh University Place, Primanti Bros., Stack'd Burgers & Beer and The Porch at Schenley.

The 3rd Annual Ramp Crawl will take place on Friday, May 5, 2017 from 4 p.m. - 7 p.m. Participants will convene at The Tent at Schenley Plaza for the kick-off.
